#### PREPARATIONS FOR THE VOWS:

1. The usual **Spiritual retreat** at DBI, Guwahati, in view of the Perpetual Profession and renewal of the vows will not take place this year due to the after-effects of Covid-19. Hence, the two clerics in Tura, namely, Clerics Sachin Kujur and Dominic Mardi, DBJC, Tura who will make the Perpetual profession but had not made their spiritual retreat, will make their Retreat (from 18<sup>th</sup> evening to 23<sup>rd</sup> evening) at Don Bosco BEd College, Tura under Fr Bivan Rodrigues Mukhim, Rector, Don Bosco College Tura. I request the community to make the necessary arrangements and thank them for their acceptance.

Cl Mawa Albert Tron (LKC), ADBU Tapesia, will make a personal or guided retreat (from  $18^{th}$  evening to  $23^{rd}$  evening), either in Khetri or in the ADBU campus, as will be arranged by Fr Stephen Mavely, Rector, before the perpetual vows on  $24^{th}$  May.

Clerics Philemon Puma, Francis Xavier and Marcus Kurbah who finished their retreat at DBRC Bangalore will join the two clerics at BEd college on 23<sup>rd</sup> (Saturday) morning to make a full day recollection before the final profession on 24<sup>th</sup> May in the morning Mass at Bosco Mount.

In this way, the clerics are given the ideal and the best opportunity to prepare themselves well and make a worthy offering of themselves to God in perpetual profession. We accompany them with our brotherly prayers and wish them all the best.

2. The clerics who will renew the vows will make a full day recollection on 23<sup>rd</sup> (Saturday) May.

In Tura, the recollection will be at BEd college and will start at 9.00 am, together with the two clerics who will already be making their retreat. Fr Bivan Mukhim, Rector will animate the recollection, organise other devotions, such as the Divine Mercy, Adoration Service, etc., and will arrange the confessors. They will renew their vows in the evening during the Eucharisitic celebration at Bosco Mount, Rongkhon, to be presided over by Fr Joseph Teron, Vice Provincial.

- 3. At Tapesia, the clerics will start the recollection at 9.00 am on 23<sup>rd</sup> (Saturday) May, and renew the vows during the Eucharistic celebration in the evening. Fr Mavely is delegated to receive the vows. The perpetual profession of Cl Mawa Albert Tron (LKC) will be on 24<sup>th</sup> May (Sunday) morning.
- 4. At Dotma, Tangla and Umswai, the renewal of the vows will take place on 24<sup>th</sup> May (Sunday) during the Parish Mass.

On 23<sup>rd</sup> May, the clerics from BTAD, Tezpur and Karbi Anglong regions will assemble at Dotma, Tangla and Umswai respectively and will make a full day recollection, starting at 9.00 am. At Dotma, Fr Thomas Lakra, at Tangla, Fr Marcus Lakra and at Umswai, Fr Tomey Anikuzhikattil will animate the recollection and will organize other devotions, such as personal adoration, Divine Mercy, etc. They are requested to make arrangements for confessors and organize one hour adoration in the evening. On the following day, they will renew their vows during the Sunday Eucharistic celebration. The confreres who have been delegated by the Provincial will receive their vows.

5. It is important that each cleric writes the formula of profession in his own handwriting correctly and ahead of time. The name of the Delegate must also be written and pronounced correctly. Our formula of profession is so rich and meaningful, both for the candidate and the faithful, that it is very important for the cleric to understand and practise it well much in advance.

- 6. The parishes and the institutions are requsted to prepare themselves well for this important event and make the celebration, solemn and devout. Kindly make sure to ask the Vice Provincial or the Secretary for the documents to be signed and also the booklet containing the Liturgy of the day.
- 7. The Rectors could discuss with the cleric(s) about the family members who might want to attend the programme. Normally we do not invite parents for the renewals. It is advisable that the family members are not inconvenienced to attend the programme during these pandemic times. But if some parents still express the desire to come, the cleric(s) will make the necessary arrangements in clear understanding with their respective Rectors and communities.
- 8. The Province will arrange for the retreat of clerics at a convenient time during the course of the year.
